About the Programme:

The Ministry of Education (erstwhile, Ministry of Human Resource Development) launched the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) in 2014 and one of its major component Teaching Learning Centre (TLC)s have been engaged in facilitating teacher training throughout the country. The Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University, Assam was set up in 2016 and it is engaged in assisting capacity building of the teachers for development of innovative skills in teaching, curriculum design, and assessment and evaluation techniques since its inception. The Centre is specifically encouraged to reach out to the teachers working in regionally disadvantaged locations of Assam and the Northeast India. The Centre offers month long Faculty Induction Programs, Refresher Courses, Short Term Courses (including Faculty Development Programs on discipline specific themes, ICT tools in Teaching, Assessment and Evaluation) and Action Research Programs. Since April 2020, TLC, Tezpur University has been conducting its programs in online mode following PMMMNMTT Guidelines and UGC Regulations. Teaching Learning Centre (TLC), Tezpur University In association with Moridhal College, Dhemaji, Assam and DCB Girls' College, Jorhat, Assam is organizing an online weeklong Faculty Development Program on Implementation of NEP 2020 in HEIs during 26 April-02 May 2023. It will

cover various aspects of implementation of NEP in HEIs. Renowned experts various institutions across the country will take sessions in the programme. The FDP will include both live sessions, Panel discussion, interactive sessions etc. The entire program will be managed through Google Classroom and live sessions will be hosted on WebEx platform. Those who fail to join the live session must watch the recorded video in a timely manner. However, joining live sessions is desirable.

- Digital Education/ Technology Enabled Learning
- Regulation and Quality Assurance
- Academic Bank of Credit
- Role of Teachers for Enhancement of Indian language, art and Culture

Course plan:

There will be approximately 35 hours of engagement including live sessions, recorded sessions, practice sessions, assignments, feedback etc.

Live interaction with resource persons

Interaction and discussion among participants through Google classroom and WhatsApp group.

Proper balance of activity and assignments.

Online Feedback on each session.

Certification criteria:

Submitting all feedback and assignments (if any) are mandatory. Payment of enrollment fee is mandatory and the same will be verified before issuing the certificates.

Completion certificates, based on participation and completion of tasks, will be awarded to the participants.

As part of the Ministry of Education's requirement under the PMMMNMTT scheme, all participants need to submit online feedback for each session. Failing to meet any of the above conditions will result in denial of a certificate of completion to the participants.

Who can apply?

The workshop is open to teachers (regular/ad-hoc/temporary) and research scholars from any Indian university/college/institutes.

Principal/academic administrator of HEIs may also apply.

NOC or Leave is not required for enrolling in the programme. However, for institutional rules if any participant takes leaves the same must be informed to TLC without fail.

How to Apply?

Interested participants are required to register online on or before **23 April 2023** by paying an enrollment fee of **INR 800/- (Non-Refundable)**.
